What is bullying?

For something to be bullying it has to have happened Several Times On Purpose. Bullying is intentional (not an accident) and repetitive. A bully hurts someone on purpose over and over again; it isn't an incident that happens only once. Bullying can be by one person or a group of people.

There are 4 types of bullying

- <u>Physical bullying</u> involves hitting, shoving, pushing, tripping, and other kinds of force.
- <u>Verbal bullying</u> involves hurtful comments, name-calling, teasing.
- Social bullying involves using friendships to hurt someone. ...
- Cyberbullying happens over mobile phones or the internet.

If you are a victim of bullying, you have a right to...

- Know that it is not your fault
- Be able to tell someone how you are feeling
- Be listened to

If you bully someone, you must understand that...

- You are making someone else unhappy
- You will be punished
- Your parents will be told

If you are a witness to bullying, it is important to...

- Tell someone what you see or hear
- Not feel that you should join in
